#### PREPARING FOR YOUR OPERATION

pre-operative phone call

 Shower or bath. Remove all: nail polish, makeup, contact lenses, jewelry (including piercings), fragrances and lotions. Do not shave operative area.

If coming in for a scheduled caesarean section - follow instructions received from maternity nurse during

- 2. Brush your teeth being careful not to swallow any of the water.
- 3. If you are staying overnight, bring a housecoat, slippers, toothpaste, toothbrush, soap, shampoo, Kleenex, feminine hygiene products, deodorant and any other necessary toiletries. The surgical unit is on 3A (ext. 3618). The maternity unit is on 1A (ext. 3624).
- 4. **Do Not** smoke or drink alcoholic beverages 24 hours before admission.
- 5. If you develop any illness or unable to come for surgery contact your surgeon immediately. For last minute illness contact day surgery at 705-759-3623 or maternity (ext. 3624) at 6 am **on the day of surgery.**
- 6. Do not work night shift the night before surgery.

#### FASTING FOR YOUR OPERATION

#### Adults:

- 7. You must fast (nothing to eat) after midnight the night before surgery
- 8. If your surgery is before 11am, no fluids after midnight.
- 9. If your surgery is scheduled after 11am, you may have one 8 ounce glass (1cup) of clear fluid 4 hours before surgery time. No orange juice, milk or milk products.
- ACCEPTABLE CLEAR FLUIDS are: apple juice, ginger ale, water, black tea or coffee (no milk/cream/whitener). No other beverages are allowed.
- 11. No candy or gum chewing is allowed.

#### **MEDICATIONS**

You have been given instructions on how to take your medications before surgery. It is important that you take your medications exactly as instructed.

If you are to take medications on the morning of your surgery, take at 6 am with a sip of water.

### Your surgery may be cancelled if you do not follow the instructions given!

<u>Do not</u> take the following medications for 7 days before surgery (unless otherwise instructed):  Take last dose on:
<ul> <li>Advil, Motrin, Ibuprofen, Aleve</li> <li>Aspirin or Aspirin products</li> <li>Herbal Supplements, Multivitamins, Vitamin E or any vitamins containing Vitamin E</li> <li>Non-steroidal Anti-inflammatories (NSAIDS)</li> </ul>
You may take Tylenol (Acetaminophen) if needed

All prescribed medications in original containers

<ol> <li>Arrange for a responsible adult to drive you home and someone must stay with you overnight.</li> <li>Wear loose comfortable clothes home.</li> <li>Do not operate a motorized vehicle for 24 hours after surgery. You could be considered legally impaired.</li> <li>At the time of your discharge you will be given information regarding follow-up care.</li> <li>Discharge time is 11:00 a.m. Please ensure you have transportation available upon discharge.</li> <li>Please bring this information sheet on your day of surgery.
