Coding review is conducted through the review of a hybrid chart (paper and electronic).

Transcription services has a 24-48 hour turnaround time.

Storage space for physical records is limited, and constant maintenance of historical records is required to allocate them appropriately.

The current system uses manual tracking and billing of invoices for the release of information.

A hybrid record means only one person can access the record at a time.

Physicians complete their deficient records in The Health Records office.

Paper records are sent to off-site storage and fees are incurred.

The new electronic chart (eChart) in Expanse will contain all electronic documentation, as well as scanned documents.

> Real-time documentation with physician documentation using PDoc.

The flow of physical records to the file room will be minimized as a result of the Meditech Scanning Desktop and departmental scanning policies.

Billing and invoices can be tracked electronically, improving efficiency.

Multiple people can access the electronic record at the same time, eliminating the need to wait for charts to be returned.

Physicians can access and complete their deficient records remotely.

Documents can be scanned into eChart, reducing the need to purge records and pay for off-site storage.
